

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
SEPTEMBER 21, 2016**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village September 21, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Joseph Schumacher, seconded by John Mette and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as read.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the board report be approved and the September bills paid.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Joseph Schumacher to pass Resolution No. 581, A Resolution of support and commitment of local funds. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Greg Oseland to pass Resolution No. 582, A Resolution to abate the water bond tax levy for 2016. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 869, An Ordinance for the levy and assessment of taxes for fiscal year ending April 30, 2017. A motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Kenneth Esker to pass Ordinance No. 869. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other action, board members tabled the codification ordinance for two weeks, denied a request from the Teutopolis Sports Backers for a donation and agreed to let an individual remove two oak trees along Columbus as long as they provide the village with a certificate of insurance naming village as additional insured.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Joseph Schumacher to go into executive session to discuss the purchase or lease of real property. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried. Following executive session no final action was taken. It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried to adjourn the meeting.
