

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
MAY 03, 2017**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village May 03, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.

President Hess swore in the newly elected trustees, treasurer and clerk, then called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Kenneth Esker and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as read.

Tony Esker reported one building permit was issued in the month of April.

After learning the villages 2007 riding lawn mower is in need of repairs a motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by John Mette to purchase a new John Deere lawn mower from Sloan Implement for \$8407. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

After review of the bids for the 2017 stockpile maintenance program a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette to award the bid for crushed stone and washed sand to Charles Heuerman Trucking. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Names picked for the summer maintenance program were Joe Runde and William Niemeyer.

Board members authorized the president to sign the audit agreement letter with Mark Kenter CPA for the 2017 audit and the agreement with the Effingham County Health Department for mosquito larviciding at a cost of \$1515.00.

In other action the board instructed the village foreman to get quotes for tree removal on Columbus street, approved the 2017 road oiling map, authorized Carl to contact CIPS for two street lights on Commercial Drive, approved changes to the building fee charges and authorized the police to proceed with the tow of an abandoned vehicle on Water street since no response from the owner. Board members also discussed changes to the residential zone of the zoning Ordinance but made no final decision.

President Hess reported that Paul Westendorf has resigned from the Planning Commission and Board of Appeals. Daniel Hoelscher will now be the Planning Commission Chairman, Bernie Hartke will replace Paul on the Planning Commission and Board of Appeals and Dean Pals will fill the unexpired term of Jerry Brummer on the Planning Commission.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Greg Oseland and carried to adjourn the meeting.
