

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 07, 2017**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village June 07, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

Daniel Zerrusen-----yes	Joseph Schumacher-----yes

It was moved by Kenneth Esker, seconded by Greg Oseland and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as read.

Tony Esker reported five building permits were issued in the month of May.

After discussing the TIF redevelopment map a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by David Tegeler to pass Resolution No. 593, A Resolution providing for notice of a joint review board meeting and public hearing concerning the consideration of a tax increment financing redevelopment plan and project in a redevelopment area in the village. By roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen, no; John Mette, yes; Kenneth Esker, no; Joseph Schumacher, yes; Greg Oseland, yes; David Tegeler, yes. 4 yes, 2 nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by John Mette, seconded by David Tegeler to donate \$500.00 to the Effingham Chamber of Commerce to cover costs of an employment survey in Teutopolis. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 880, An Ordinance amending title XI of Ordinance No. 870, Code of Teutopolis, regulating the hours of operation for the sale and consumption of alcohol. A motion was made by Kenneth Esker, seconded by Joseph Schumacher to pass Ordinance No. 880. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Daniel Zerrusen reported the sidewalk committee recommends replacing approximately 60 feet of sidewalk on the west side of Wessel's Grocery. Board members agreed to this recommendation and will have the village employees do the work.

In other action, the board discussed bent ends, clogged and other problems with culverts throughout the village as well as sidewalks that are uneven. Board members agreed to each take a section of the village, review sidewalks in that area and then prioritize the areas to be repaired.


