

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
FEBRUARY 19, 2020**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village February 19, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 20th.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the board report be approved and the February bills paid.

After reviewing the estimate to repair the backhoe, a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to authorize Carl to spend \$10,023.00 for the repairs. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Michelle Fombelle addressed the board and requested an extension to fix the sanitary sewer connection violation at their residence at 417 West Elm due to inclement weather. The board agreed to give them an additional 60 days to complete the work making the total time 90 days.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 936, An Ordinance authorizing execution of Release of Reservation of Reverter for Lot 44 in Prairie View Subdivision. A motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 936. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Shannon Woodard presented estimated figures for sewer rate increases and other ordinance changes. The sewer committee will meet, review and make recommendations to full board at the next meeting.

Board members reviewed updated cost figures for a new village hall and will make a determination at the next meeting whether to approve the design contract to proceed with the project.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried to adjourn the meeting.
