

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MARCH 04, 2020**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village March 04, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

A motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Resolution No. 622, A Resolution approving the replot of lots 2 and 3 in Prairie View Subdivision. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Bernard Hartke to approve spending \$56,000 for the civil and design phase of the new hall and authorize the president to sign the contracts. By roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen, no; John Mette, yes; Jane Summers, yes; Bernard Hartke, yes; Greg Oseland, yes; David Tegeler, yes. 5 yes, 1 nay, motion carried.

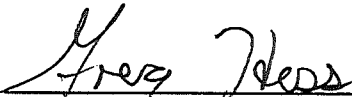
The sewer committee reported they met and recommend doing a four year rate increase with increases being reviewed after 2 years but requested the board table any increase until the water committee reviews those rates so both utilities will be on same schedule. Board members agreed to this recommendation.

In other action, Bernard Hartke updated the board on the progress with CSX railroad addressing the drainage issues along their right of way, heard from Jane Summers and David Tegeler on the mapping progress, discussed solar panels and heard from President Hess that Leon Gobczynski contacted him requesting a memorandum of understanding for the school regarding TIF funds.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by John Mette to go into executive session to discuss the purchase or lease of real property. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Following executive session no action was taken. It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried to adjourn the meeting
