

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
DECEMBER 2, 2020**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held at Siemer Milling Company, 111 West Main Street, December 02, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

The President, via WebEx, called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by John Mette and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

The board heard from Nolan Schumacher on changing the ordinance to allow chickens. He presented research from other towns that allow chickens. Jeremy and Michelle Niebrugge, Joe Siemer and Anne Wessel voiced support for Nolan's request. Daniel Zerrusen and John Mette agreed to meet with Nolan to draft a plan on how to enforce the ordinance and then present to the board for a vote.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Resolution No. 630, A Resolution approving WSD subdivision plat. By roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen, yes; John Mette, abstained; Jane Summers, yes; David Tegeler, yes; Bernard Hartke, yes. 4 yes, 0 nays, 1 abstained, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion made by John Mette, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to waive the water bill penalties until further notice. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by David Tegeler, seconded by John Mette to approve Christmas bonuses for Village employees. Full-time employees will receive \$150 and part-time employees \$75. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by David Tegeler, seconded by John Mette to pay Grunloh Building \$94,548.13 for pay estimate #3 for work complete on the new Village Hall. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen seconded by John Mette and carried to adjourn the meeting
