

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MARCH 03, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village March 03, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Tony Esker reported one building permit was issued in the month of February.

After hearing the backhoe needs new rear tires the board authorized Carl to purchase two Harvest King tires from T-Town Auto at a cost of \$1189.68.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 957, An Ordinance authorizing the execution of release of reservation of reverter for SNB Investments LLC-Lot 18. A motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 657. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by John Mette to approve OFS invoice in the amount of \$4,769.01 for kitchen furniture at the hall. By roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen, yes; John Mette, yes; Jane Summers, yes; David Tegeler, yes; Greg Oseland, abstained; Bernard Hartke, yes. 5 yes, 1 abstained, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to approve Grunloh Building's pay estimate #6 in the amount of \$46,541.35 for work completed on the village hall. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette to approve GFI Digital's invoice of \$9,195.34 for copiers at the hall. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Greg Oseland to approve two docking stations from Magoo and Associates in the amount of \$2,828.60 for the police dura book laptop. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to purchase one solar radar speed sign from Radar Sign at a cost of approximately \$4,023.00. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

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Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to purchase one solar radar speed sign from Elan City at a cost of approximately \$3,189.00. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

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Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette to pass Resolution No. 632, A Resolution adopting the Effingham County Multi-Jurisdictional all hazards mitigation plan. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

In other action, the board tabled the Prairie View sidewalk project for phase 1 until further information is obtained, heard from President Hess that Reta Swingler is willing to do additional duties and learn the computer for the treasurer position, discussed street lights and sign for Prairie View Subdivision, heard from Jane Summers on a complaint she received about loose rock on Green Street and David Tegeler reported on ITEP grants for sidewalks and on an unsewered grant program the village may qualify for.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried to adjourn the meeting.
