

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING

FEBRUARY 17, 2021**

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the board report be approved and the February bills paid.


After reviewing the sidewalk bids for phase one of the prairie view subdivision the board decided to table making a decision for two weeks.
