

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MARCH 17, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village March 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and place on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by John Mette and carried that the board report be approved and the March bills paid.

Tony Esker reported 3 new building permits issued in March.

Carl Pals addressed the board about a utility company hitting the main water line on Southern Row on March 10th causing the entire Village to be without water for approximately two hours.

John Stone was present to answer any questions the board had about the sidewalks in Phase I of Prairie View Subdivision. He also reported he rode the Village streets with a Village employee to see which streets are in need of repair this year.

Eric Pals with Tick Tock Energy reported that the solar panels on the new Village Hall are up and running. He also reported after the panels have been energized for six to eight months the Village should receive the SREC payment.

Motion was made by Dan Zerrusen, seconded by John Mette to approve the sidewalk quote from John L. Lewis Concrete for \$139,369.50 for Phase I in Prairie View Subdivision. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.



Motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 958. By Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

In other action the board approved the petty cash to be increased from \$25 to \$50 and agreed to start adding penalties again with March water bills.
