

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
MAY 05, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, May 05, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Tony Esker reported 1 new building permit was issued in May.

Board members discussed and agreed to make changes to the golf cart ordinance. The changes will be adding a crossing at Race St. and changing the operating age from 21 to 18. The village attorney will be contacted to make the changes to the existing ordinance.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Resolution No. 633, A Resolution approving WSD subdivision plat. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

The Board discussed TIF legislation updates proposed by the House and Senate. Village President Dave Repking will contact legislators to support or oppose the potential new changes.

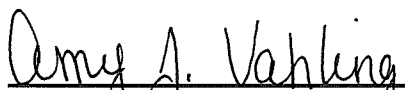
Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 962, An Ordinance Authorizing the Execution of Release of Reservation of Possibility of Reverter (Marjorie J. Haarmann- Lot 60). A motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 962. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger to go into executive session to discuss collective negotiating matter between the public body and its employees or representatives or deliberations concerning salary schedule for one or more classes of employees. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Following executive session, a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger to grant a 4% pay increase across the board, retroactive to May 1<sup>st</sup>. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other action, the board approved the advertisement of stockpile bids for rocks and sand and discussed the oiling and maintenance of Village streets,

It was moved by Greg Oseland seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried to adjourn the meeting.
