

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MAY 19, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village May 19, 2021 at 7 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the board report be approved, and the May bills paid.

Carl Pals informed the board the chop saw they currently use needs replace and the window air conditioning unit at the Water plant no longer works. The board approved Carl to purchase a new chop saw for around \$1,100 from Dust & Sons and to replace the window unit at the water plant.

Courtney Yockey from The Alliance was in attendance to introduce himself to the board. He updated the board about a County wide mapping program that will be starting this Fall.

Luke Eastin with SCIRPDC attended to answer any questions the board had about our current TIF agreements. He also advised the board on yearly payouts for current TIF agreements.

Kathy Hartke with the Teutopolis Park District addressed the board about a drainage problem the north side of the park by Snake Trail. The ditch is always filled with water causing the side to be rutted up when people park along the road. It also causes mosquitoes to be a problem. The Village engineer was present and said that he would go out there and see what could be done to fix the problem.

John Stone with Connor and Connor updated the board about the revised 2021 maintenance work and the sidewalks in Prairie View Subdivision.

The board agreed to add Amy Vahling and David Repking as authorized signers on bank accounts. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nay, 1 absent, motion carried.

After reviewing the 2021 stockpile maintenance bids a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to accept Three Sisters Logistics bid of \$15.62 a ton for crushed stone and \$10.78 a ton for washed sand. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to pay Grunloh Building Inc. final pay estimate #7, contingent on final walk thru. Then the Village President will approve based on the final walk thru. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nay, 1 absent, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 964, Appointment Ordinance for fiscal year 2022. A motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 964. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Daniel Zerrusen introduced Ordinance No. 965, An Ordinance Authorizing Execution of Release of Reservation of Possibility of Reverter (Bradley E. Jeffries and Laura K. Jeffries – Lot 25). A motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 965. By roll call vote – 5 yeas, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Daniel Zerrusen introduced Ordinance No. 966, An Ordinance Authorizing Execution of Release of Reservation of Possibility of Reverter (Brent Sandschafer and Holly Sandschafer – Lot 19). A motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 965. By roll call vote – 5 yeas, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to approve Resolution No. 634, A Resolution Authorizing the Execution of Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement for Emergency Situations. By roll call vote – 5 yeas, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger to approve Resolution No. 635, A Resolution Authorizing Teutopolis for Tomorrow to Conduct a Golf Cart Event. By roll call vote – 5 yeas, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 967, An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 851 and Title VII, Traffic Code, of Ordinance No. 870, “Code of Teutopolis” in Regard to Golf Carts. A motion was made by Angela Kroeger, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 967. By roll call vote – 5 yeas, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other business the board agreed to move the due date of the water bills to the 25th of the month starting in September 2021 and discussed public use of the new Village Hall.

It was moved by Greg Oseland seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried to adjourn the meeting.
