

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 16, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village June 16 ,2021 at 7 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held by the board to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 17th.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried that the board report be approved, and the June bills paid.

Phil Repking was present to address the board about the driveway from his house to his shed. Currently the drive going to the shed is rock, but the covenant states the drive must be concrete, asphalt or brick. He requested an extension until 2023 to complete this project, because he does not have the time to do this project currently. He also stated he would like to see what his real estate taxes are going to be before anymore concrete is poured. The board told Phil they would discuss, and he should come back to the July 7th meeting.

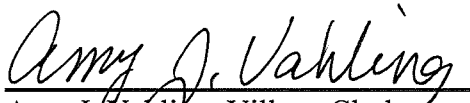

Motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 968. By roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to accept the John L. Lewis Concrete bid for repairs on Harvester Street in the amount of \$14,450.00. By roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.


In other action the board agreed to shut down Elm Street to the railroad tracks for Cruise Night at the KC Hall, approved the \$1,000 bond reimbursements to Lot 25, Lot 26 and Lot 54 in Prairie View Subdivision and discussed appropriations for Fiscal Year 2022.
