

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
July 21, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village July 21, 2021, at 7 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Angela Kroeger, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by David Tegeler, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by David Tegeler, seconded by Jane Summers, and carried that the board report be approved, and the July bills paid.

Carl Pals the Village Foreman addressed the board about a business that will be expanding on the west end of town, and their need for a sewer line. There is an abandoned sewer line in that area. Carl said the abandoned line looks good and the expanding business could probably use the existing line, but he is going to check with the engineers to make sure. He also reported that 8 fire hydrants in town need replaced. The board advised him to get bids on replacing the 8 fire hydrants.

Residents of Prairie View were present to update the board. They informed the board they now have a committee formed to represent the subdivision. Once they have a list of items, they would like to see amended they would like to address the Architectural Committee.

Area residents addressed the board on allowing side by sides in village limits. After discussion, the board informed the group they would work on preparing an ordinance to allow side by sides. The ordinance should be ready for the board to vote on at the August 18th meeting.

Cheryl Meeker address the board on how building permits are issued in the village. The board informed her of the steps that had to be taken to obtain a permit. She also asked about the alley that runs behind their home on Main St. After discussion the board agreed to have our village engineers come out and survey the ally.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 970. An Ordinance Making Appropriations for the Corporate Purpose of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, Illinois, for the Fiscal Year Commencing May 1, 2021, and ending April 30, 2022. Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 970.


Roll Call Vote - 5 Yes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent, motion carried.
