

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
SEPTEMBER 15, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village September 15, 2021, at 7 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the board report be approved, and the September bills paid.

Monica Stortzum and Nancy Pals from the Teutopolis for Tomorrow Beautification Committee addressed the board. Their committee would like to place 10 flowerpots in front of businesses along Main Street. These pots would be purchased from Potted Charm. Once the flowerpots are purchased, they would ask local businesses to sponsor a flowerpot, for \$250 per year, this would help with care for the shrubs and flowers. The board agreed they would put this on the next agenda and vote to pay for the flowerpots.

The board reviewed the Compliance Review covering receipts and disbursements of MFT funds from January 01, 2020, through December 31, 2020.

Motion made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Greg Oseland to pass Resolution No. 640, A Resolution of Financial Commitment for Illinois Safe Routes to School Grant Program – Cycle 2021 project. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion made by Greg Oseland, seconded by David Tegeler to pass Resolution No. 641, A Resolution Approving a Subdivision Plat Drew Holman Subdivision. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland Introduced Ordinance No. 972, An Ordinance Authorizing the transfer of Real Estate (Lot 16 – P.E.L. Land Trust). Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 972. By roll call vote - 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Ordinance No. 973, An Appointment Ordinance for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois was tabled until the next meeting.

The board voted to terminate the current health insurance plan for Village employees and to enroll the Village employees in a new health insurance plan. The Village will now offer the employees a LIVE360 health plan. The new plan year will run from October 1, 2021, thru September 30, 2022. By roll call vote - 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.


The board discussed updating the utility billing and accounting software. They choose to switch to Muni-Link for utility billing and Quickbooks as the new accounting software. These changes will be implemented over the next several months.

In other action the board discussed making Jane Summers an additional notary for the Village, the Village President informed the board the Village received our NEU check for \$111,610.20, and the board agreed to add \$150 to village employees' HSA accounts.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen seconded by Jane Summers and carried to adjourn the meeting.
