

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
NOVEMBER 03, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, November 03, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Bernard Hartke seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Tony Esker reported no new building permits.

The board approved Carl Pals request to hire an excavator operator to clean ditches out and to take down dead trees at the lagoon. The board also advised him to go out for quotes on the cost to replace the waterlines on Elm St.

Police Chief Jeff Bushue address the board about hiring a part-time officer to assist with nights and weekends. The board agreed to advertise the position.

Motion made by David Tegeler, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Resolution No. 642, A Resolution for MFT Funds. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 1 absent, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion made by David Tegeler, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to pass Resolution No. 643, A Resolution to Abate Tax Levy for the Year 2021. By roll call vote - 5 yes, 1 absent, 0 nays, motion carried.

Daniel Zerrusen introduced Ordinance No. 976, An Ordinance for the Levy and Assessment of Taxes for the Fiscal Year Commencing May 01, 2021, and Ending April 30, 2022, of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County Illinois. Motion by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 976. By roll call vote - 5 yes, 1 absent, 0 nays, motion carried.

Daniel Zerrusen introduced Ordinance No. 977, An Ordinance Authorizing the Transfer of Real Estate. (David & Joyce Toombs – Lot 15) Motion by Angela Kroeger, second by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 977. By roll call vote - 5 yes, 1 absent, 0 nays, motion carried.


The Village Attorney will be contacted to draw up a Side-by-Side Ordinance. The Ordinance will be voted on at an upcoming meeting.


The board tabled discussion on changes to the Covenants in Prairie View Subdivision.
