

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
November 17, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, November 17, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and place on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the board report be approved, and the November bills paid.

Tony Esker reported 1 new building permit for November.

Prairie View residents were present to address the board about portable sheds in Prairie View. After discussion, the board agreed to contact the attorney and have an amendment drawn up. The amendment would need to be signed by at least 70% of the lot owners in Prairie View to change the covenants of the subdivision.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 978, An Ordinance Regulating Parking on a Portion of E. State Street Within the Corporate Limits of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, Illinois. Motion by Bernard Hartke and seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 978. By roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motions carried.


