

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
DECEMBER 15, 2021**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, December 15, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the board report be approved, and the December bills paid.


Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 980, An Ordinance Amending Chapter 71 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois (Golf Carts and Recreational Off-Highway Vehicles). Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Jane Summers to pass Ordinance No. 980. By roll call vote – 4 yes, 1 nay, 1 absent - Daniel Zerrusen – yes, Jane Summers – yes, Angela Kroeger – yes, Greg Oseland – yes, Bernard Hartke – nay, David Tegeler was absent, motion carried.


Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 981, An Ordinance Defining Meeting and Adopting Procedures for Public Participation for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois. Motion by Jane Summers, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 981. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

The board agreed to use TIF II money to pour a concrete sidewalk by the water tower located next to Stevens Industries' parking lot. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

The board did not make a motion to go into executive session.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried to adjourn the meeting.
