

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MAY 04, 2022**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, May 04, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Tony Esker reported 4 new building permits.

Village Foreman, Carl Pals had President Repking ask the board if he could tile the ditch along Pearl Street between Elm St. to K of C ball diamond drive. He feels this would need to be completed because digging the ditches out will make them very steep. The board agreed for safety this area should be tiled.

Tom Wegman addressed the board to see if the board would consider extending sidewalks out to the new Stevens Industries addition. The board agreed to take this into consideration and told him they would discuss at a future meeting.

Representatives of the Teutopolis Cruise Night committee were present to inform the board of their event they have coming up on June 17th. They are planning a cruise from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and a car show from 5:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. They also informed the board they will have additional signage and security at the event this year.

Lee Beckman with Milano & Grunloh Engineering was present to update the board on the \$250,000 Safe Routes to School grant the Village received. This grant will be an 80/20 split and they hope to start the project in the Spring of 2023.

Motion by Greg Oseland, second by David Tegeler to accept the Safe Routes to School Design Engineering Agreement with Milano & Grunloh in the amount of \$30,000. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion by Greg Oseland, second by David Tegeler to accept the Safe Routes to School Construction Engineering Agreement with Milano & Grunloh in the amount of \$25,000. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

After reviewing the 2022 stockpile maintenance bids a motion was made by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Jane Summers to accept Three Sister Logistics bid of \$15.85 a ton for crushed stone and \$11.90 a ton for washed sand. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Motion by Greg Oseland, second by Daniel Zerrusen to pass Resolution No. 646, A Resolution appropriating MFT funds for the maintenance of streets with the tilling option. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland Introduced Ordinance No. 987, An Appointment Ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2023. Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 987. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

In other action Village President, David Repking informed the board that all liquor licenses were renewed and distributed to their establishments, the board also agreed to hire Clarity Window Cleaning to wash the windows at Village Hall on a quarterly basis at \$225 per cleaning, the board also agreed to hire a summer office helper.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Greg Oseland and carried to adjourn the meeting.
