

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 01, 2022**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, June 01, 2022, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 989, An Ordinance Authorizing Grant of Easement – Project Ameren Illinois Company, d/b/a Ameren Illinois, an Illinois Corporation. Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 989. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

The board discussed applying for an ITEP sidewalk grant. This grant would help construct sidewalks though out the Village. After discussion, a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to move forward, and apply for the ITEP sidewalk grant. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

The board discussed IDOT Agreement Amendment No. 1 for work performed on the shoulders of Route 40 going through the Village. Motion by Greg Oseland, second by Daniel Zerrusen to accept IDOT Agreement No. 1. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Jane Summer to pass Resolution No. 647, A Resolution Amending the Funding for the IDOT Shoulder Project. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other action, the board spoke about several lots in town that need to be mowed, these lots will be sent to the attorney. They also discussed, rental of the conference room for professional business meetings, they agreed a deposit of \$100 will need to be put down to rent the conference room and if the room is left in good condition the \$100 will be refunded.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried to adjourn the meeting.
