

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JULY 06, 2022**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, July 06, 2022, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Angela Kroeger, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Tony Esker the Village building inspector reported one new building permit. He also reported the Planning Commission will meet on July 13th.

Village Foreman, Carl Pals, was not in attendance, but asked President Repking to address the board about purchasing a utility truck from the Village of Montrose. The truck is a 2017 2500 HD with a utility bed. The board agreed to discuss and possibly take action at the next board meeting.

The board discussed the appropriations for FY 2023. A few changes will be made and will be voted on at the next meeting.

Motion by Greg Oseland, second by Daniel Zerrusen to pay Farmweld \$7,963.10 on TIF contract number 1 and to pay \$20,777.44 on Farmweld TIF contract number 3. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

After discussion, the board decided to not make a decision on renewing the LIVE360 health insurance for Village employees. This will be discussed again at a future meeting.


The board discussed finalizing the project map for the ITEP sidewalk grant the Village will be applying for. After discussing they all agreed they would like to include additional sidewalks on the west side of the Village. Milano and Grunloh will be contacted to add these additional sidewalks and a new project map will be made to vote on at the next meeting.

The board approved to spend up to \$140,000 for the purchase of a vac truck for the Village. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

In other action, the board discussed funds the Cruise Night committee would like to donate to the Village for a beautification project, discussed abandon cars, stripping on State Aid Road and an upcoming TIF committee meeting on August 3rd.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried to adjourn the meeting.
