

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 15, 2022**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, June 15, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 16th.

It was moved by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Angela Kroeger, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and place on file.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Angela Kroeger, and carried that the board report be approved, and the June bills paid.

Daniel Zerrusen introduced Ordinance No. 990, An Ordinance Renumbering Ordinance No. 989, An Ordinance Authorizing Grant of Easement. Motion by Jane Summers, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 990. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to approve a payment of \$29,321.18 from TIF II account to Siemer Milling Company for 2020 payable 2021 real estate taxes. Daniel Zerrusen, yes, Jane Summers, abstain, Angela Kroeger, yes, David Tegeler, yes, Greg Oseland, absent, Bernard Hartke, yes. 4 yes, 0 nays, 1 abstain, 1 absent, motion carried.


After discussion about the Village purchasing a vac truck the board agreed to table it until the next meeting.

There was a motion by David Tegeler to donate \$500 to the Effingham Noon Rotary for the annual Effingham 4th of July Fireworks Display. After discussion the board decided not to donate money for the display.


Motion by David Tegeler, seconded by Bernard Hartke to award the 2022 MFT street maintenance bid to Larry Heuerman in the amount of \$81,708.05. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other action, the board approved Carl Pals to purchase a pressure washer, President Repking brought up about possibly raising the monthly stipend for board members and the board also agreed to create a TIF committee. The new TIF committee will consist of Daniel Zerrusen, Jane Summers, David Tegeler and Greg Oseland.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Jane Summers, and carried to adjourn the meeting.
