

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JULY 20, 2022**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, July 20, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and place on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke and carried that the board report be approved and the July bills paid.

Tony Esker reported 1 new building permit in July.

A resident at 304 W. Main Street addressed the board about flooding that occurred on her property during a recent storm. She had pictures so the board could see how bad the flood was. President Repking said that he would speak with Village Foreman Carl Pals and see if anything could be done to fix the problem.

Kevin Ruholl from the Garage Band Music Night committee was present to ask for an extension to the golf cart/side by side curfew on August 13, 2022. The board agreed they would allow golf carts/side by sides until 10 p.m. on the 13th.

Lee Beckman was present to give updates on the grants the Village has already applied for and grants that the Village will be applying for soon. Lee had a preliminary map laying out where the ITEP sidewalks would be constructed. In August the Village will start the application process for the ITEP grant. The update on the unsewered grant was the grant agreement for the engineering has been received and work can be started. The Village will apply for the second step of the unsewered grant soon. The Safe Routes to School grant project is tentatively set to start construction in 2023.

After discussing the project map for the ITEP grant a motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Jane Summers to finalize the project map for the ITEP sidewalk grant. Roll call – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke to purchase a 2017 Chevy Silverado 2500 HD truck with a utility bed from the Village of Montrose. Roll call – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.





Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 991, An Ordinance Making Appropriations for the Corporate Purposes of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, Effingham, Illinois, for the Fiscal Year Commencing May 01, 2022 and Ending April 30, 2023. Motion by Bernard Hartke, second by Angela Kroeger to pass Ordinance No. 991. Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

In other action, the board discussed a sink hole on Elm Street and getting a postage meter at Village Hall.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Angela Kroeger and carried to adjourn the meeting.
