

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
February 15, 2023**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, February 15, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

The Mayor Pro-Tem, David Tegeler, called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 16th of February.

From Magoo and Associates, John McGuire was present to address the board on the new 2023 Service Plans available. The new plan will provide an extra layer of cyber security and supply the training we need to comply with new State of Illinois mandates. The board thanked him for his time and said they would discuss it.

Lee Beckman from Milano & Grunloh was present to update the board on the grants the Village has applied for. He reported the Village will need to send CSX Railroad \$15,950 so they can review the time and material costs of the project up to the construction phase of the project. The board approved this payment to be made to CSX Railroad.


