

ORDINANCE NO. 999

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 71 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS, ILLINOIS
(GOLF CARTS AND RECREATIONAL OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, is authorized pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-1426.1 to designate one or more specific streets under the jurisdiction of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, as egress and ingress routes for the use of non-highway vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, currently regulates the use of golf carts and recreational off-highway vehicles on streets under the jurisdiction of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, pursuant to Chapter 71 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, has considered the volume, speed and character of traffic on the streets within the corporate limits of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, further deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, to amend certain provisions of Chapter 71 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, as provided for herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS, EFFINGHAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: The findings made in the prefatory portion of this Ordinance are hereby adopted.

Section 2: Paragraph C of Section 71.03 of Chapter 71 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as follows:

“C. No permit shall be granted unless the following conditions are met.

- (1) The Non-Highway Vehicle must be inspected by the Village Chief of Police, or his or her designee, to ensure that the vehicle is safe to operate on the Village Streets and is in compliance with the requirements of this Chapter.
- (2) A physically handicapped applicant requiring a Non-Highway Vehicle modified with hand controls must submit a certificate signed by a physician

that the handicapped applicant is able to safely operate a motorized Non-Highway Vehicle in compliance with this Chapter.

- (3) With regard to Recreational Off-Highway Vehicles (commonly known as side-by-sides) only, the applicant's place of domicile must be located either: (1) at a Teutopolis, Illinois, 62467 mailing address; or, (2) within one and one-half (1.5) miles from the corporate limits of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois."

Section 3: Except as herein expressly modified by Section 2 above, the provisions of Chapter 71 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Invalidity. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction declares any particular provision of this Ordinance to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed to be valid and enforceable. The invalidity of any part of this Ordinance shall not affect any other part or parts thereof.

Section 5. All prior ordinance or resolution of the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois, contrary to the terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.


