

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
MAY 01, 2024**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, on May 01, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

During Wednesday’s meeting, a representative of the Teutopolis Knights of Columbus named John Burford requested the installation of a new streetlight. The proposed location for the streetlight is by their entrance on Vine Street. After discussing the matter, the board agreed to contact Ameren to obtain an estimate for the installation. Once the estimate is received, the board will review and discuss it further.

During the meeting, resident Robert Campbell brought up the topic of amended changes to the restaurant liquor license. He mentioned that he heard about these changes on the radio and was surprised to find out that cocktails were now allowed under this license. Campbell informed the board that he had previously attempted to obtain a restaurant liquor license but was told none were available. The board informed Campbell they were unaware of his past attempts to apply for the restaurant liquor license.

Item (a) the discussion and possible action on Plot Twist parking improvements was table. President Repking will reach out to Lee Beckman to see other options.

Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to award the 2024 Stockpile bid to Heuerman Bros. Trucking. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 1048, an Ordinance Approving Installation of “No Soliciting Without a Permit” Signage Within Village Right-of-Way. Motion by Christina Mette, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to pass Ordinance No. 1048. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 1049, An Ordinance Authorizing Purchase of An Easement for Sidewalk and Utility Purposes (2024 ITEP Project) (Stephen & Marlene Hille – 503 W. Northern Row). Motion by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to pass Ordinance No. 1049. Roll call vote 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 1050, An Ordinance Authorizing Purchase of An Easement for Sidewalk and Utility Purposes (2024 ITEP Project) (Derek & Maci Meinhart – 415 S. Smith Street). Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Angela Kroeger to pass Ordinance No. 1049. Roll call vote 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.

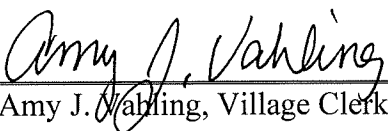

The board discussed the Road Oiling Map for 2024. They plan to contact the Village Engineer for help with getting estimates. This will be discussed at the meeting on May 15th.

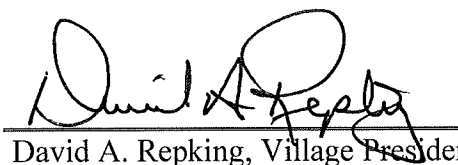
