

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING

JULY 08, 2024**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, on July 08, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

Building Official Tony Esker gave updates on various building and solar projects.

Village Foreman Carl Pals reported a large sinkhole on N. Garrett Street that requires emergency repairs. The Board advised him to repair the 20ft section and install a manhole. If further repairs are needed, then they will line this section. He also reported the survey on the catch basins is halfway completed.

David Tegeler introduced Ordinance No. 1055, An Ordinance Establishing Salaries for the Village President and Trustees of the Village Board for the Village of Teutopolis, Illinois. Motion by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Greg Oseland to pass Ordinance No. 1055. Roll call vote – Dan Zerrusen – Nay, Angela Kroeger – Yes, Bernard Hartke – Yes, David Tegeler – Yes, Greg Oseland – Yes, Christina Mette – Yes – 5 Yes, 1 Nay, motion carried.




The Board will wait until the July 17<sup>th</sup> meeting and discuss the ITEP easement agreements with a representative from Milano & Grunloh.
