

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
SEPTEMBER 04, 2024**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, on September 04, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

Lori Runde from Farmweld was present to discuss extending the sidewalks at the east end of town. They would like to see the sidewalks extended to Farmweld Avenue. Trustee Tegeler said he would reach out to Lee Beckman to discuss it further.

Courtney Yockey was present to discuss the six Comprehensive Plan Proposals the Village received. After discussion, the Board advised the Village Clerk to contact Dr. Andrew Greenlee from the University of Illinois. The Board would like to have a Teams conference to discuss their proposal.

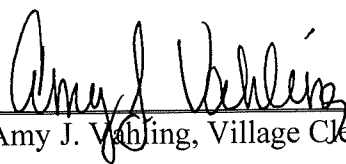
Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 1062, An Ordinance Authorizing Execution of Release of Reservation of Possibility of Reverter (Gebben Construction LLC – Lot 52). Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by David Tegeler to pass Ordinance No. 1062. 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

Greg Oseland introduced Ordinance No. 1063, An Ordinance Authorizing Purchase of an Easement for Sidewalk and Utility Purposes (2024 ITEP Project) (Thomas E. Mette & Margaret A. Mette – 600 S Wooden Shoe Rd.). Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Bernard Hartke to pass Ordinance No. 1063. Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to approve Allstate as the new employee health insurance plan. The new plan year will begin on October 01, 2024. Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

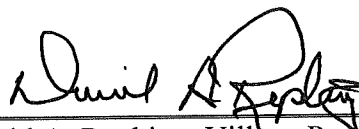
