

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
SEPTEMBER 18, 2024**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village, on September 18, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

It was moved by Bernard Hartke, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Christina Mette, and carried that the board report be approved and the September bills paid.

Tony Esker reported three new building permits were issued.

Village Foreman Carl Pals reported that three aerators at the lagoon have stopped working. The board advised Carl to purchase the aerators and to buy an additional one to keep in stock. The total cost for these aerators will be around \$36,600. Carl also reported that the emergency siren near the Teutopolis Junior High School was not working. The quote to replace this siren is \$36,400. The board approved both emergency repairs.

Mitch Hardiek from Milano & Grunloh was present to give the monthly grant and project updates. Items discussed: ITEP will be submitted by September 30th, waiting on NOFO for Unsewered Grant, Safe Routes to School is moving forward, we will submit for the IEPA loan in the next few months for the Cast Iron Grant, STU Funds project is in the design stage, continued design work on Pearl Street Reconstruction, discussed railroad drainage, F & C Concrete will repair various sidewalks, Effingham Asphalt will pave State Street and a portion of John Street, discussed a mapping system for water and Heuerman Trucking did not have enough oil to complete the MFT project this year.

Jim Quatman and Bob Zerrusen informed the Board they purchased 416 E. Main Street. They will tear down the home. After the house is torn down, they will split the 60-foot lot evenly.

Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen to approve the sidewalk reconstruction bid to F & C Concrete and Excavating for \$43,284.00. Roll call vote – 6 yes, 0 nays, motion carried.



Roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen – no, Angela Kroeger – yes, Bernard Hartke – yes, David Tegeler – yes, Greg Oseland – yes, Christina Mette – yes – 5 yes, 1 nay, motion carried.

Motion by David Tegeler, seconded by Bernard Hartke to approve the State Street asphalt bid to Effingham Asphalt for \$158,719.40 and Milano & Grunloh engineering bid of \$24,275.25. Roll call vote – Daniel Zerrusen – no, Angela Kroeger – yes, Bernard Hartke – yes, David Tegeler – yes, Greg Oseland – yes, Christina Mette – yes – 5 yes, 1 nay, motion carried.


