

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Jerry Runde, a representative of the Teutopolis Park District, was present. He said the park board will be filling out a TIF application to request assistance on an upcoming project.

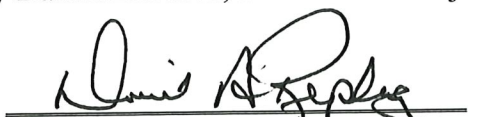
