Motion by Robin Imburgia, seconded by Christina Mette, to approve a liquor license to Anora Belle's DBA Brickbat Alley. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Bernard Hartke, to approve JB Eskers' Pay Estimate 4 for \$30,184.18 for Prairie View Phase 2 Sidewalk Project. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Bernard Hartke introduced Ordinance No. 1115, An Ordinance Authorizing Purchase of an Easement for Sidewalk and Utility Purposes. (Wendy S. Hawickhorst – 209 S. Oak Street) Motion by Greg Oseland, seconded by Christina Mette, to pass Ordinance No. 1115. Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Christina Mette, to recess into Executive Session for the purpose of consideration of the following subjects, pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2 (c): Personnel – Section 2 (c) (1). Roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

In other action, the board approved the \$1,000 Lot Bond back to Patrick and Julie Zuber (Lot 27 Prairie View), \$150 Christmas bonuses to full-time and part-time employees, and agreed to let William Hardiek roll his unused vacation and personal days over to 2026.
