

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 17, 2026**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village on June 17, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order, and upon roll call, the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late, the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 18th.

Tony Esker reported one new building permit.

Mitch Hardiek updated the Board on the application period for the ITEP Grant and reported that the John Street Box Culvert Project is expected to begin in early July. He also reported that A&A Concrete was the lowest bidder for the STU Project with a bid of \$274,477. The project agreement will be administered directly between IDOT and A&A Concrete. The STU funding for the construction phase of the project is \$219,581.60, with the Village responsible for the remaining balance of the project cost. In addition, representatives met with the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) to discuss the Oak Street and Pearl Street railroad crossings.

It was moved by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by Robin Imbrugia, and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as presented.

It was moved by Christina Mette, seconded by Daniel Zerrusen, and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by Christiana Mette, seconded by Robin Imburgia, and carried that the board report be approved and the June bills be paid.

Motion by Daniel Zerrusen, seconded by David Tegeler to approve a Project Authorization Agreement Between the Village of Teutopolis and Milano & Grunloh for preliminary platting, street design & construction engineering for potential new TIF 3 subdivision.
Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays, 2 absent. Motion Carried.

Item (b) Discussion and possible action to approve a bid from Badger in the amount of \$3,000 for ten new water meters was tabled.

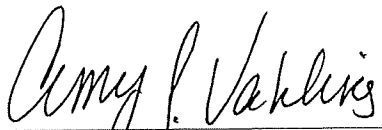

Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

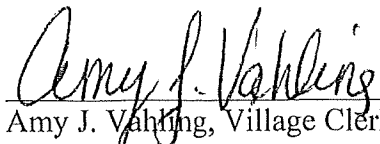

Roll call vote – 4 yes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

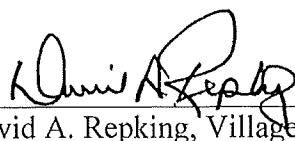
No action was taken following Executive Session.
